

LEARNING ONLINE Safety for Students

PARENT GUIDANCE



- Monitor the length of screen time and encourage regular breaks.
- Monitor your child's posts and encourage them to be polite, use kind words and avoid posting any negative comments.
- Establish a daily schedule and routine for learning, set up a specific work space and integrate play and practical learning as well as online tasks.
- Locate the computer in a public space and check regularly that your child is on task.
- Only use school approved communication portals and platforms.
- Ensure your child does not put personal details or photographs online.
- Make sure your computer has parental safety controls set on your computer or device.
- Maintain social connections with peers through monitored online interactions.
- Report any unkind comments or conversations to your child's teacher.
- Talk with your child about their responsibilities when posting and commenting online about others.
- Remember that teachers or other students can see into your home if video is switched on, consider cultural sensitivities.

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STUDENT GUIDANCE

- Do not share content or ideas without saying where you got them. Avoid posting spam or links to websites not associated with your learning.
- Be aware of images in the field of view of your camera when in online discussions.
- Respect all users, be polite and use kind words. Avoid posting any negative comments.
- Only use school approved communication portals and platforms.
- Do not share links that may have pop up adverts which may be culturally sensitive.
- Do not put personal details or photographs online.
- Don't take screen shots or video yourself or others in online conversations.
- Use English in all conversations except when in Arabic lessons.
- Contact your teacher if you have any worries or concerns.
