Message from the Principal

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We hope this message finds you well. We would like to inform you about an important upcoming assessment period for our students this May — the GL Progress Tests, along with the ABT (Arabic, Islamic, and Social Studies Benchmark Tests).

These standardized tests play a vital role in tracking each student's academic progress from one year to the next — in this case, from the 2023–2024 academic year to 2024–2025. The GL Progress Tests assess students in English, Mathematics, and Science, while the ABT exams will assess Arabic, Islamic, and Social Studies.

All exams will be conducted **online in the computer lab.** Each year group will receive a detailed schedule to ensure all students have adequate time and access to complete their tests in the computer lab.

What You Need to Know:

- · Assessment Period: Throughout May
- GL Tests: English, Mathematics, and Science
- ABT Tests: Arabic, Islamic, and Social Studies
- Format: Standardized online tests, scheduled per year group
- Feedback: Results from all tests will be shared with students and parents after completion

To ensure students are well-prepared, we are currently conducting mock exams, which simulate the real test environment and allow teachers to identify areas for improvement. Mock results will be shared with parents to provide transparency and help guide further revision at home.

In the lead-up to the tests, teachers and subject leaders have:

- Integrated practice questions into daily lessons
- Prepared revision booklets aligned with test formats
- Set personal academic targets for every student in all test subjects

Your Support Matters

We place great value on parental involvement in helping our students succeed. Your encouragement at home is key to motivating students to take these exams seriously and strive to exceed their targets.
