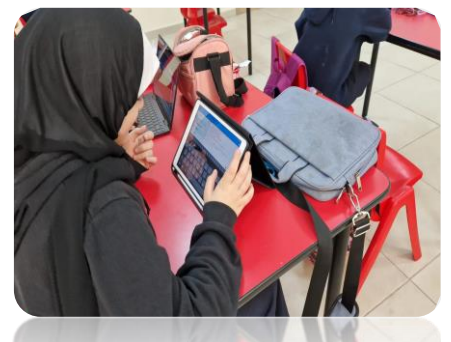
Prep School
