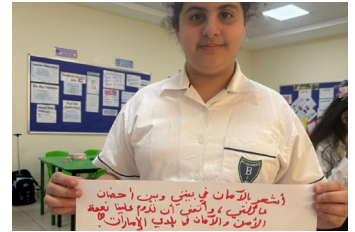

HEALTH AND SAFETY

ADOSH-SF Audit Update – Belvedere International School

Belvedere International School (BIS) recently underwent the ADOSH-SF Annual Third-Party Audit, reaffirming the school's strong commitment to health, safety, and continual improvement.

The BIS management demonstrated clear leadership and dedication by complying with the audit requirements under the Abu Dhabi Occupational Safety and Health System Framework (ADOSH-SF). The audit team acknowledged that the school presented reasonable evidence supporting compliance with the mandatory requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Management System (OSHMS).

It is important to note that the audit process is based on random sampling; therefore, it may not capture every detail of the system. As such, some gaps may still exist that were not identified during the audit or explicitly mentioned in the final report. The conclusions drawn reflect the auditors' best professional judgment based on the documents reviewed, observations made, and processes evaluated during the audit.

Nbiz Infosol also emphasized that the responsibility for maintaining and continuously improving the effectiveness of the management system rests with the school. While the audit provides valuable insights, it should not be considered a comprehensive identification of all strengths or areas of non-compliance.

Next Steps:

- Findings and required corrective action plans arising from identified non-conformities and observations will be initiated and coordinated with the relevant departments and managers.
- Opportunities for improvement highlighted during the audit will be reviewed internally and incorporated into the school's continual improvement processes where beneficial.
- BIS remains committed to fostering a safe and healthy environment for all students, staff, and visitors through ongoing evaluation and enhancement of its safety systems.

Shelter-in-Place Emergency Drill – April 24, 2026

Belvedere International School successfully conducted a Shelter-in-Place Emergency Drill on April 24, 2026, at 9:45 AM as part of its ongoing commitment to safety preparedness.

During the drill, students and staff responded promptly and followed the established emergency procedures. The transition from classrooms to designated safe zone areas was completed efficiently, with an evacuation time of 48 seconds, demonstrating a high level of awareness and readiness across the school community. The drill provided an opportunity to reinforce the importance of:

- Staying calm and alert during emergency situations
- Following designated shelter-in-place procedures
- Moving quickly and safely to assigned safe zones

The school continues to review and improve its emergency response systems to ensure the highest standards of safety for all students and staff. We commend everyone for their cooperation and active participation in making this drill a success.
