## Message from the Principal

### The Importance of School Inspections in Promoting Excellence

#### Dear Parents,

At Belvedere International School, we are committed to providing the highest quality education for our students. A key component in achieving this is through regular school inspections, which play a vital role in promoting a culture of excellence.

The UAE inspection framework, implemented by the Abu Dhabi Department of Education and Knowledge (ADEK), serves as a guiding tool for all schools in the UAE to align with the country's long-term educational goals as part of the National Agenda.

### **Background of Irtiqua Inspections**

The Irtiqaa program of inspection was initiated by ADEK in 2008, with preliminary surveys conducted prior to comprehensive inspections starting in the 2009-2010 academic year. Initially focusing on private schools, the program expanded to include public schools in the 2012-2013 academic year, ensuring a comprehensive evaluation of educational institutions across the emirate.

### Educational Landscape in Abu Dhabi and Al Ain

Understanding the scale of education in our region provides context to the importance of these inspections. As of the latest available data, Abu Dhabi hosts a significant number of schools, with a considerable portion located in the Al Ain region. This extensive network of educational institutions underscores the need for rigorous inspection frameworks like Irtiqaa to maintain and elevate educational standards.

### **UAE's Progress in International Assessments**

The UAE has demonstrated remarkable progress in international educational assessments, reflecting the effectiveness of initiatives like Irtiqaa:

• TIMSS 2023: The UAE ranked first in the Arab world, with fourth-grade students improving by 17 points in mathematics and 22 points in science compared to the 2019 results. Eighth-grade students also showed significant gains, with a 15-point increase in mathematics and a 14-point rise in science.

• PISA 2022: While UAE students scored below the OECD average in mathematics, reading, and science, the nation is committed to continuous improvement. In mathematics, 51% of UAE students attained at least Level 2 proficiency, compared to the OECD average of 69%. Efforts are ongoing to enhance these outcomes in future assessments.

### **Arabic Department**








### **Inclusion**
