Teachers are at the heart of preparing students for success. Beyond designing and administering assessments, teachers continuously **motivate** their students, encourage a growth mindset, and set **high expectations** for every learner.

They guide students through effective revision strategies, provide feedback to strengthen learning, and ensure that every classroom environment remains inspiring, inclusive, and focused on achievement. Teachers also collaborate closely with HoDs to maintain consistency across subjects and ensure that all assessments meet the school's academic standards.

This week, our students continued to extend their learning beyond the classroom through enriching educational experiences.

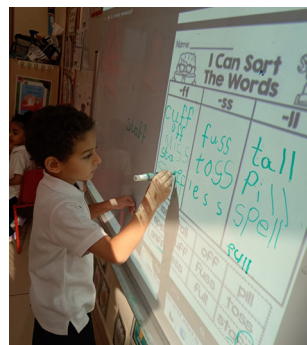
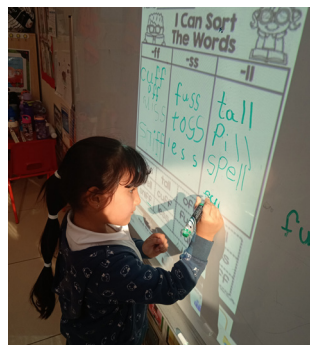
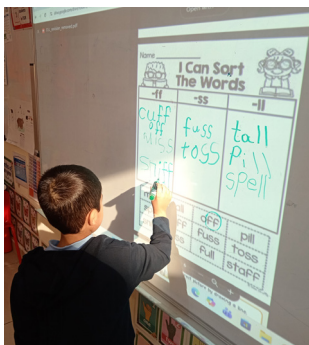
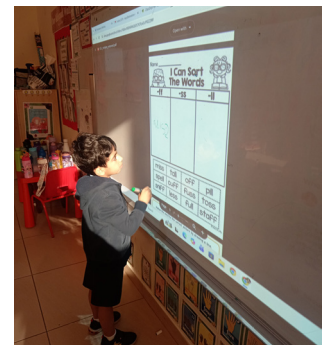
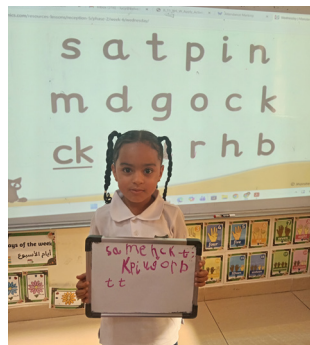
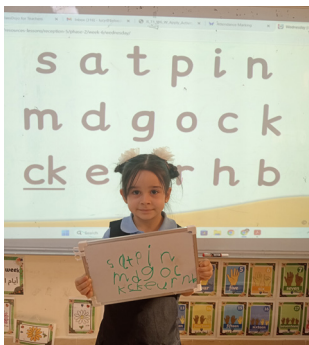
