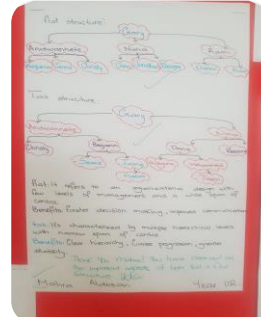
Prep School
